



SEW-EASY SKIRT

Workshop duration	2 x 5 hours
Level of skill required.....	Beginners
Participants to bring.....	Skirt pattern (the instructor will advise suitable options) Pattern trace Fabric Interfacing (requirements will be discussed in first class) Elastic (requirements will be discussed in first class) Interfacing (requirements will be discussed in first class) Matching thread Contrasting thread (for tacking)
Other tools required.....	Sewing machine & accessories Overlocker (if you have one) Tape measure, pins, needles Pen/pencil for marking pattern Fabric marking pen Cutting shears

What will you learn?

- How to take accurate measurements and then make pattern adjustments to suit your body shape
- Inserting an invisible zipper
- Finishing raw seam edges
- Creating a hem that doesn't sag
- Creating and attaching a waistband

OR

- Creating an elastic waist facing – a comfortable alternative to a waistband

The emphasis will be on using constructions techniques that produce professional results. The end result will be a simple, straight, unlined skirt.

Choosing your fabric

Refer to your pattern for recommended fabrics. Avoid large checks or plaids that require matching at seams. As this skirt will not be lined, take care to choose a fabric that has sufficient body.
